FEAST OF ST. BRIGID 'Mary of the Gael' Sunday 1st February She was born c454 at Faughart to a pagan chieftain Dubhtach and a Christian mother Broicseach. She made her religious vows before St. Mel of Ardagh. With St. Conleth she founded the double monastery of Kildare. She was renowned for her deep spirituality, inspirational leadership, tender compassion, warm hospitality and selfless charity. She died on 1st February 524 and is buried at Downpatrick with the other two patrons of Ireland, Patrick and Columba (Colum Cille). *A Naomh Bríd a Mhuire na nGael, scar orainn do bhrat.
