Weekly Reflection. Do I have a heart? In October 2025 in Dilexit Nos ('He Loved Us'), his final encyclical, Pope Francis invited us back to the heart of Christian faith - the Sacred Heart of Jesus - as an antidote to a superficial, 'heartless' world. A world that has become 'heartless' and indifferent to greed and war, and a Catholic Church in need of revitalizing its missionary joy need to open themselves up to Christ's infinite love. However, he wrote, 'when we witness the outbreak of new wars, with the complicity, tolerance or indifference of other countries, or petty power struggles over partisan interests, we may be tempted to conclude that our world is losing its heart.' So, as we approach the feast day of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (this coming Friday, June 12th) -

Sacred Heart of Jesus Healing Prayer Sacred Heart of Jesus, I pray for Your healing touch upon my body, mind and spirit. I ask you to remove any fear or anxiety. Fill me with the peace that You alone can give. I place myself completely in Your hands. I lift up all my afflictions in Your hands, Lord, for You are the Divine Healer with Divine Mercy. Sacred Heart of Jesus, I trust in You completely.
