September 7th Canonisation of Carlo Acutis: A Witness for Our Times Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991–2006) was a young Italian teenager with a deep love for the Eucharist and devotion to Our Lady. Using his talent with computers, he created a website to share Eucharistic miracles with the world. Carlo lived a life of faith, joy, and service, reminding us that holiness is possible even in ordinary daily life.

He is often called a "patron for the digital age", showing how technology can be used to spread the Gospel. Pope Francis beatified Carlo in 2020, and his example continues to inspire young and old alike.
