WHAT A SUNNY DAY ORDAINED.

On 13th June 1976, during one of Ireland's warmest summers, six young men were ordained to the priesthood for our diocese. Among them was Fr. Cathal Faughnan, whose vocation would touch countless lives over the decades that followed.

Fr. Cathal came to our parish in 2008 and faithfully served our community for sixteen years, until ill health brought his active ministry to a close. Throughout those years, he was a devoted and caring shepherd to his people. He walked with families through life's most important moments — baptising children, celebrating marriages, comforting the sick, offering wise counsel, and praying with families as they entrusted loved ones to God's eternal care. His quiet dedication, kindness, and steadfast presence enriched our parish immeasurably. While he never quite managed to convert everyone to supporting Leitrim football over Roscommon, he was a wholehearted supporter of parish life and took a genuine interest in the people he served. On Friday, 12th June, by arrangement with his family, we were delighted to welcome Fr. Cathal to our parish Mass for a simple and intimate celebration of his priestly ministry. A small presentation was made as a token of our affection and gratitude.



Though memory may sometimes fade, the goodness Fr. Cathal shared among us remains deeply cherished. More importantly, every prayer offered, every kindness shown, and every life touched through his ministry is forever held in the loving memory of God. As we give thanks for Fr. Cathal's years of faithful service, we continue to keep him and his family in our prayers. May the Lord who called him to serve His people bless him with peace, comfort, and every grace in the years ahead.
