Feast of All Saints & All Souls Wednesday next is the feast of All Saints and is a Holy Day. Mass in Keadue at 10a.m. and Ballyfarnon at 7 p.m. Conditions for Indulgences From 12 o'clock on 1 November until midnight on 2 Nov., all who have a) confessed, b) received Communion c) prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence - applicable only to the souls of the departed - by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.
